GENERAL

The Kytherian Greek Dance Lessons are held weekly during each school term. It is important that all students enrolled and their families, carefully read this document and ensure you understand your obligations.

- All students must be enrolled as a Kytherian member, through Family Membership, to be enrolled for Friday night Greek Dancing lessons.
- All classes are closed (meaning only the teacher and students are permitted in the dance hall). There will be one class per term where parents will be invited to watch their children.
- If you need to speak to the teacher, the committee member present will advise the teacher and the teacher will give a suitable time for this to occur.
- Children are not to exit the building unless accompanied by an adult, guardian or caregiver.
- There is no smoking or drinking permitted on the property (as per venue rules).
- Food must only be consumed in the waiting area and all rubbish is to be appropriately disposed of.
- Chewing gum is prohibited and only water is permitted inside the dance hall in a spill-proof water bottle.
- To ensure fairness, all students are placed in their corresponding school year group.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn by every student.
- Parents/caregivers must actively supervise siblings and students waiting, at all times.
- Photography and video recording is prohibited in the dance hall.
- All Greek dancing participants including students, teachers and parents/caregivers are to treat each other with respect, and any breaches may be handled in line with the KAA constitution.
- All students are encouraged to participate in performances.

PERFORMANCES

- All students must fill out a performance slip and return to the teacher to ensure that every student has a costume for performances.
- All items required to be worn by each student must comply with the notification the teacher has handed out prior to the event.

- Any costumes received by students on the day of the event must be returned to the teacher after each performance.
- All students must have a minimum of 80% attendance through the year (or discretion of the dance teacher) to be eligible for participation in performances.
- Any new students who have enrolled mid-year or later will be permitted to perform only with the permission of the teacher.

CODE OF CONDUCT – STUDENT

- Demonstrate respect to teachers, parents, staff and other students.
- Serve as a role model to younger dancers and ensure appropriate language and behaviour is displayed.
- Attend class regularly, unless ill or injured, or in the event of a school function.
- Wear correct clothing and dance shoes.
- Report any incidents etc immediately to the teacher.
- Show commitment and positivity while working to the best of your own ability.
- Communicate with the teacher if you have an injury, illness, or personal circumstance that may affect your effort.
- Mobile phones during classes are strictly prohibited – switch mobile phones to silent mode and leave them in the classroom with your other valuable items.
- Take care of your belongings.

CODE OF CONDUCT – PARENTS/GUARDIANS/VISITORS/VOLUNTEERS

- Participate in a respectful environment.
- Ensure students arrive on time for classes and rehearsals, noting that late arrivals are disruptive to the teacher and other students.
- Collect students from classes on time and communicate with the dance teacher and/or staff by phone if you will be late.
- Report any incidents etc immediately to a staff member.
- Communicate absences to staff members.
- Keep children home if they are unwell or injured.
- Actively supervise siblings and tidy the waiting areas after use.
- Take responsibility to read any updates and keep up to date with your membership fees, current activities and important information.
- Respect that the teacher's decisions are final with regard to student participation in events.
- Support by encouraging children to show commitment and positivity while working to the best of their own ability.
- Ensure that all siblings and non-dancing students are looked after whilst classes are on.
- Do not take photos or videos of classes, or other children without prior permission.
